

# OTISS TRAIN



## Oklahoma Tiered Intervention System of Support- Training in Response to Assessment and Instructional Needs

- TRAIN is the support system developed and funded by the Oklahoma SPDG II to provide training and support to selected sites interested in implementing OTISS.
- Dr. Gary Duhon, Associate Professor, School of Psychology, Oklahoma State University (OSU); Dr. Laura Riffel, Behavior Consultant; Oklahoma SPDG Staff; OTISS External Coaches (OSU Doctoral Students); and the Oklahoma Parent Center provide services to sites through this support system.
- Sites apply annually via an application process to receive this support. Sites will qualify either as a Level I OTISS Site, Level II OTISS Site, or a Level III OTISS Site.
  - The SPDG Staff provides Level I Sites with materials, tools, and information via e-mail and opportunities for professional dialog through an OTISS Forum and Blog. An OTISS Web Site is also being developed to provide professional development/support.
  - Level II Sites receive all the services that Level I Sites receive. In addition, they receive **targeted** on-site support from the OTISS External Coaches.
  - Level III Sites receive all the services that Level I and II Sites receive. In addition, they receive **intensive** support from the OTISS External Coaches.
