CT SPDG Post-Assessment

WHAT is it?

The SRBI Self-Assessment is used by the CT SPDG to measure progress of implementation of SRBI at all participating schools. The assessment consists of 45 indicators across four general areas: System of Instruction, System of Assessment, System of Decision Making, and Leadership.

Educators are asked to rate each indicator according to a 4-point rubric, where “0” = no implementation; “1” = initial implementation; “2” = partial implementation; and “3” = full implementation. Educators are also asked to provide “evidence” or written comments to support their rating of each indicator.

WHO completes it?

Your school completed a pre-assessment in Phase I of Implementation and is now being asked to complete a post-assessment as part of Phase III. All members of the School Leadership Team should complete the self-assessment.

WHERE is it completed?

To complete the online self-assessment, please go to bit.ly/C2PostSRBI. It should take approximately 20 minutes to complete. For your convenience, there is a Save and Continue feature at the bottom of each page. If at any time you wish to save your responses and continue the assessment later, just click on this button. After completing the full assessment, you will also be able to print a copy of your answers.
