Your problem statement (#1 above) may be related to your system or yourself; the Root Cause that you list here should be related to either, as long as it maintains a focus on adult efforts (i.e., systems) and should feature alterable variables (things that <i>can</i> be changed).

Whatever you do should ultimately change the situation and remove the challenge you referenced in step 1 above. <i>What can you work on? What can you put in place?</i>	Set a target or goal for your implementation. Once you have seen it "in effect", what will be different than the current state.
